

OBITUARIES:

THOMAS HOLLINGSWORTH, aged 78, of Mallorytown, near Brockville, Ontario, Canada, died en route to a hospital (January, 1971) after he was found suffering from malnutrition and pneumonia in a farmhouse. \*  
A hospital spokesman said his brother, Bert Hollingsworth, 73, who also lived in the farmhouse, was suffering from malnutrition, frost-bitten feet and possible pneumonia. He was in satisfactory condition. Police said the men apparently became ill and were unable to care for themselves. Thomas and Bert Henry are children of the late Thomas and Ellen (Stennett) Hollingsworth, grandsons of Thomas and Margaret (Carberry) Hollingsworth - who came to Canada about 1837 - and great grandsons of John Hollingsworth of Rock Big, Arklow, Co.
