

Hollingsworth ... fond of winners' circle...

All of a sudden, there seems to be no stopping John Hollingsworth. The retired Vancouver millionaire had drawn a blank in the first 14 days of the meet, then he broke his "maiden" with a win with his veteran mare, Brown Flare, Monday.

Then Tuesday night, he scored twice more with Holridge Command, a three-year-old colt, and a four-year-old filly, Mooney Point. And he did it with a flourish, lowering their career marks in each case. Holridge Command (\$9.50) went his mile in 2:06, while Mooney Point (\$7.50) took the eighth by a length and a quarter over Senga Bogey in 2:03:1.
