(8) William Wai Lee Chong, of Calgary, Alberta, Canada, sued Capt. Ed Ostrum and employee Richard Hollingsworth of the Salvation Army. Why? Lee Chong claimed Hollingsworth told Calgary police Chong threatened Ostrum and then on 9 Feb 1983 they raided Chong's apartment, and caused damage and forfeiture of his damage deposit.
