

(5) The Toronto City Directory, 1868/69, p. 23, under Loyal Orange Lodge of British America (love that phrase "British America") the Grand Officers for 1868/69 were

Grand Chaplain, Rev. Stephen Lett, LL.D.

Ogle R. Gowan, in 137 masters of OLC 1867.

Gowan was the founder of the Orangemen in Canada, a cousin of some of our Wexfords (his aunt was married to our Frederick's uncle, John Hollinsworth of Ballycanew, shopkeeper), and another John, of Enniscorthy, Co Wexford, was close in association to the Stephen Lett, father of above man. Killian's Red Ale, marketed by Adolph Coors Brewing Company, mentions George Killian, but in fine print he is correctly called George Killian LETT. But "Lett" doesn't sound Irish to American advertisers (damn them), so they call him George Killian. We reminded Coors in a hot letter. You betcha!
